Faculty of Arts and Social Sciences

FASS is available throughout the calendar year and is located at the north of campus close to our Guest Rooms. It is a flexible, flat floored meeting space with plenty of natural daylight. The space can be subdivided into two rooms, both equipped with AV facilities; including a projector, microphones and the ability to host hybrid meetings.

The large meeting room comfortably accommodates up to 34 people, and the smaller meeting room provides space for up to 24 people.

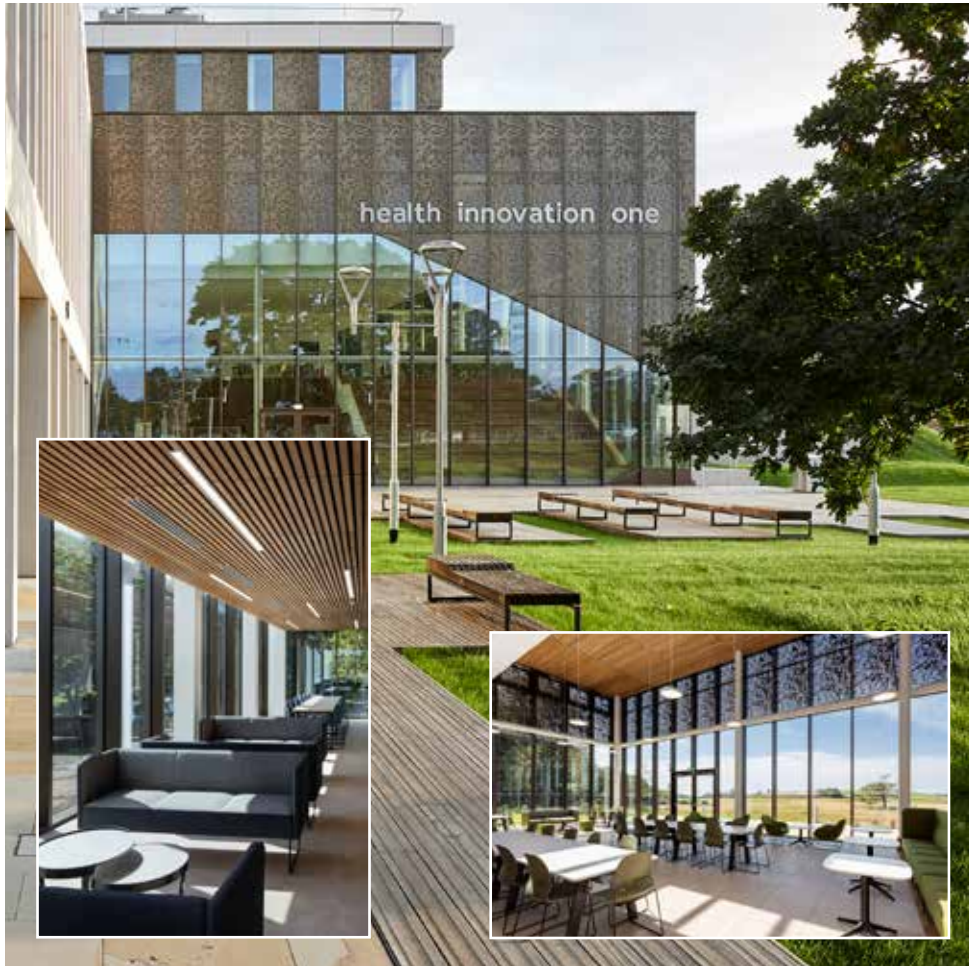

George Fox

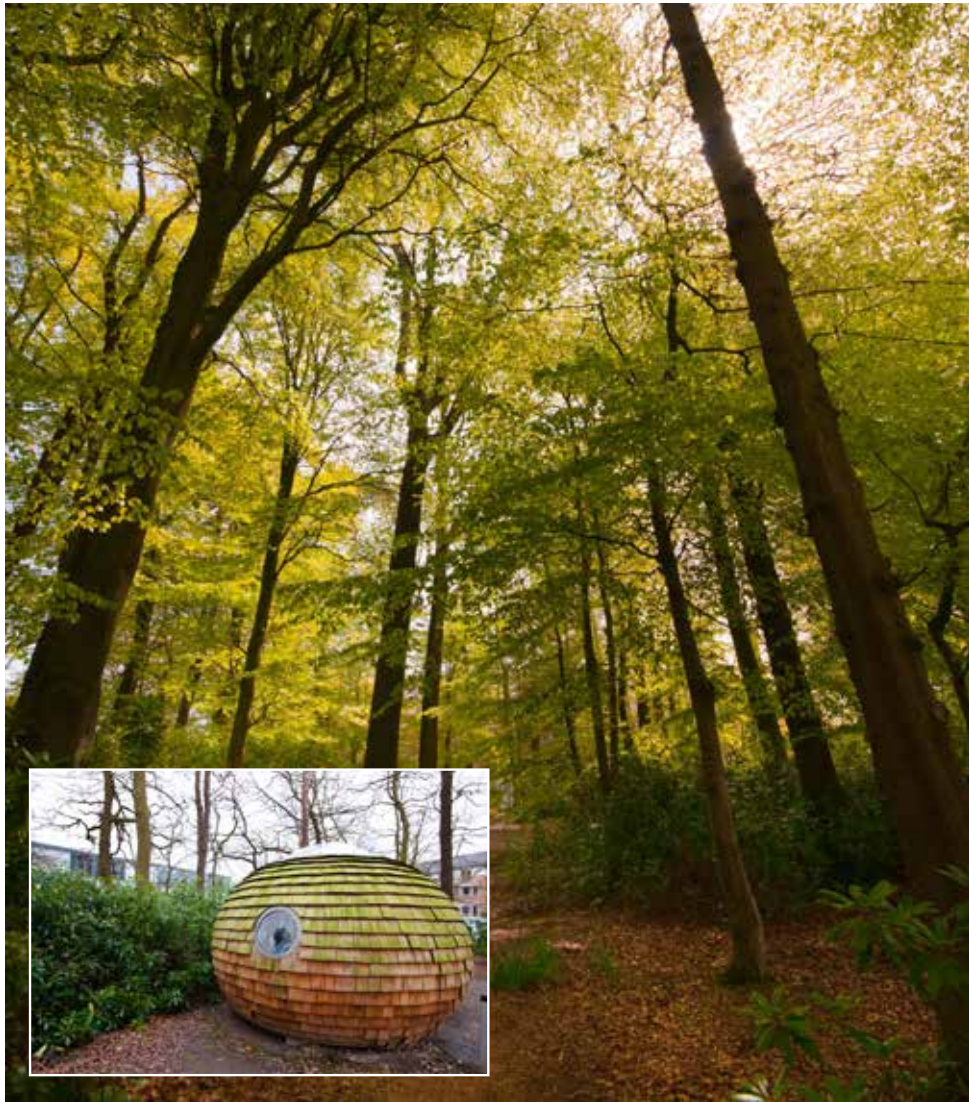

Sustainability

Changing how our campus is powered is a key part of our commitment to achieve net zero. Lancaster University is the highest producer of renewable energy of all UK Universities according to figures published by the Higher Education Statistics Agency. We have already reduced our electricity and heating emissions by 50% since 2005.

Our commitment to become carbon neutral by 2035 is written into Lancaster University's strategic plan. The wind turbine produces 11-17% of the University's electricity and demonstrates our commitment to carbon reduction and sustainability.

Where to find us

Lancaster is conveniently located in the centre of the UK surrounded by the beautiful mountains of the Lake District and a stunning coastline. Lancaster is easily accessible being just over two hours from London and Edinburgh on the West Coast Line and well served by the main line rail.

The M6 motorway (the backbone of Britain) provides quick and convenient car travel to the length of the country. In just over an hour from Manchester, Liverpool and Leeds you could be exploring our beautiful city.
